The Key Stage 2 Children's Computing team met to decide what were the rules that every child should use when using Computing equipment in school. Please read them and sign to say you understand them and agree with them.

Do enjoy using the equipment and learning new skills.

Do take care of all the equipment and don't break anything.

Don't use the computers to access social networks & talk to people including people who may ask you to do something wrong, share wrong ideas, share photographs or meet up.

Do leave the laptop and l-pad trolleys tidy, the cables untangled & plugged in.

Do listen to instructions and use the equipment correctly when you are told to.

Don't use websites that you are not allowed to including those which give wrong messages & inappropriate material.

Don't try to find inappropriate webpages or pictures. Stick to what you are told and only use the internet with a member of staff present.

Do tell the member of staff if you see something that is wrong on the screen or see something that upsets you.

Do be careful with a keyboard so you don't type something inappropriate or scary.

Don't take photos of any child where we don't have the parent's permission.

Don't download apps or programs because they may contain viruses, scams or inappropriate materials.

Don't take inappropriate photos of others and post them on the web.

Do keep your password safe and don't tell anyone it except the class teacher.

Do be safe in Computing lessons by not swinging on the chairs and keeping liquids away from the equipment.

Don't use the equipment to do something that will upset someone else, including taking part in cyberbullying.

Don't waste ink and paper by printing when you don't have to and don't print inappropriate things. Only print when you are told to.
